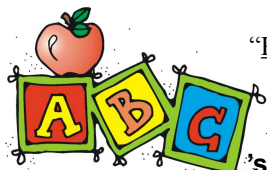

Church Requel Will Be Moving!

I shared this news last week, but not everyone was here so I thought it worth repeating. Beginning June 27th, Church Requel will begin conducting its services every week at the church facilities of Ontario Christian Fellowship, located at 636 S. Lexington-Springmill Rd. You might recall that we met there for Palm Sunday and Easter.



Subsequent to those weekends, the leadership of Church Requel has been in prayer and discussion with the leadership of OCF. They have been most generous to make their facility available to us on a weekly basis for our evening services. Our board of directors have decided to make this move for several great reasons:

1. We will have access to the facility each and every weekend. This will provide us with greater stability.
2. The children's rooms are fantastic at OCF. We believe that growing our children's ministries is one important key to our future growth.
3. We'll begin by meeting in the chapel space (same place we met before.) But as our church grows, OCF will make available to us their new auditorium space - one of the finest church meeting facilities in the area!
4. Our weekly occupancy expense will be 1/3 less at OCF than it is at Mid-Ohio. And this includes access to the children's rooms. Also, we love the idea that our rental expense will be supporting another fantastic ministry!

I'll talk a little more about this during our announcement time tonight. Tonight, we plan to conduct our first-ever Church Requel community meeting at the conclusion of our church service. This will be a forum where we can discuss our plans and answer any questions that you may have about our relocation. However, I'm also available to talk to any of you privately about this decision. If you wish me to contact you this week, just write "OCF" on the back of your Info Card and I'll give you a call.

We have often emphasized that the church is much more than just a building. I have also often joked that anyone can worship with Church Requel, providing that they can first find us! Hopefully this move will give us a more permanent location that will help people know where to find us. For some, I'm sure, the fact that our church is actually meeting in a church will be a positive. However, I want to emphasize the most important aspect - one I'm sure you all will agree with - it really doesn't matter where we meet, so long as we continue meeting! I'm at Church Requel when I'm with you! We want to make this move and *leave no one behind*. Know how much I love you!
