



#1 - I stand ALONE and ACCUSED by my wrongs.

*The teachers of the law and the Pharisees brought in a woman caught in adultery. They made her stand before the group and said to Jesus, "Teacher, this woman was caught in the act of adultery."*

*"Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour."*  
1 Peter 5:8b NIV

*"The accuser of our brothers and sisters, who accuses them before our God day and night, has been hurled down."* Revelation 12:10b NIV

#2 - Jesus stands for GOD'S LAW ...

*"Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them."* Matthew 5:17 NIV

*"In the Law Moses commanded us to stone such women. Now what do you say?" They were using this question as a trap, in order to have a basis for accusing him.*

*"If a man commits adultery with another man's wife... both the adulterer and the adulteress are to be put to death."* Leviticus 20:10 NIV

#3 - ... And Jesus stands for GOD'S RIGHTEOUSNESS.

*When they kept on questioning him, he straightened up and said to them, "Let any one of you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her."* John 8:7 NIV

*"At this, those who heard began to go away one at a time, the older ones first, until only Jesus was left, with the woman still standing there."* John 8:9 NIV

*"God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God."* 2 Corinthians 5:2 NIV

#4 - I stand with Jesus UNCONDEMNED.

*Jesus straightened up and asked her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?"  
"No one, sir," she said. "Then neither do I condemn you." Jesus declared. "Go now and leave your life of sin."* John 8:10-11 NIV
