

9 PRINCIPLES OF MINISTRY

Luke 10:1-16 NIV



#1 - The Principle Of PARTNERSHIP .

"After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go." v.1

#2 - The Principle Of THE FINISH .

He told them, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field." v.2

#3 - The Principle Of WEAKNESS .

"Go! I am sending you out like lambs among wolves." v.3

#4 - The Principle Of FOCUS .

"Do not take a purse or bag or sandals; and do not greet anyone on the road." v.4

#5 - The Principle Of TRUST .

"When you enter a house, first say, 'Peace to this house.' If someone who promotes peace is there, your peace will rest on them; if not, it will return to you. Stay there, eating and drinking whatever they give you, for the worker deserves his wages. Do not move around from house to house." v.5-7

#6 - The Principle Of DIPLOMACY .

"When you enter a town and are welcomed, eat what is offered to you." v.8

#7 - The Principle Of SHOW AND TELL .

"Heal the sick who are there and tell them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.'" v.9

#8 - The Principle Of GOD'S JUDGMENT .

"... It will be more bearable for Tyre and Sidon at the judgment than for you. And you, Capernaum, will you be lifted to the heavens? No you will go down to Hades." v.10-15

#9 - The Principle Of AGENCY .

"Whoever listens to you listens to me; whoever rejects you rejects me; but whoever rejects me rejects him who sent me." v.16
