- Exo 18:9 And Jethro **rejoiced** for all the good that the Lord had done to Israel, in that he had delivered them out of the hand of the Egyptians.
- Lev 23:40 And you shall take on the first day the fruit of splendid trees, branches of palm trees and boughs of leafy trees and willows of the brook, and you shall **rejoice** before the Lord your God seven days.
- Deut 12:7 And there you shall eat before the Lord your God, and you shall **rejoice**, you and your households, in all that you undertake, in which the Lord your God has blessed you.
- Deut 12:12 And you shall **rejoice** before the Lord your God, you and your sons and your daughters, your male servants and your female servants, and the Levite that is within your towns, since he has no portion or inheritance with you.
- Deut 12:18 but you shall eat them before the Lord your God in the place that the Lord your God will choose, you and your son and your daughter, your male servant and your female servant, and the Levite who is within your towns. And you shall **rejoice** before the Lord your God in all that you undertake.
- Deut 14:26 and spend the money for whatever you desire—oxen or sheep or wine or strong drink, whatever your appetite craves. And you shall eat there before the Lord your God and **rejoice**, you and your household.

- Deut 16:14 You shall **rejoice** in your feast, you and your son and your daughter, your male servant and your female servant, the Levite, the sojourner, the fatherless, and the widow who are within your towns.

Deut 26:11 And you shall **rejoice** in all the good that the Lord your God has given to you and to your house, you, and the Levite, and the sojourner who is among you.

Deut 27:7 and you shall sacrifice peace offerings and shall eat there, and you shall **rejoice** before the Lord your God.

Deut 32:43 “**Rejoice** with him, O heavens; bow down to him, all gods, for he avenges the blood of his children and takes vengeance on his adversaries. He repays those who hate him and cleanses his people’s land.”

Deut 33:18 And of Zebulun he said, “**Rejoice**, Zebulun, in your going out, and Issachar, in your tents.

Judg 9:19 if you then have acted in good faith and integrity with Jerubbaal and with his house this day, then **rejoice** in Abimelech, and let him also **rejoice** in you.

Judg 16:23 Now the lords of the Philistines gathered to offer a great sacrifice to Dagon their god and to **rejoice**, and they said, “Our god has given Samson our enemy into our hand.”

1 Sam 2:1 And Hannah prayed and said, “My heart exults in the Lord; my strength is exalted in the Lord. My mouth derides my enemies, because I **rejoice** in your salvation.

1 Sam 6:13 Now the people of Beth–shemesh were reaping their wheat harvest in the valley. And when they lifted up their eyes and saw the ark, they **rejoiced** to see it.

1 Sam 11:15 So all the people went to Gilgal, and there they made Saul king before the Lord in Gilgal. There they sacrificed peace offerings before the Lord, and there Saul and all the men of Israel **rejoiced** greatly.

1 Sam 19:5 For he took his life in his hand and he struck down the Philistine, and the Lord worked a great salvation for all Israel. You saw it, and **rejoiced**. Why then will you sin against innocent blood by killing David without cause?”

2 Sam 1:20 Tell it not in Gath, publish it not in the streets of Ashkelon, lest the daughters of the Philistines **rejoice**, lest the daughters of the uncircumcised exult.

2 Sam 6:12 And it was told King David, “The Lord has blessed the household of Obed–edom and all that belongs to him, because of the ark of God.” So David went and brought up the ark of God from the house of Obed–edom to the city of David with rejoicing.

16:31 Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth **rejoice**, and let them say among the nations, "The Lord reigns!"

29:9 Then the people **rejoiced** because they had given willingly, for with a whole heart they had offered freely to the Lord. David the king also **rejoiced** greatly.
- 2 Chron  
6:41 "And now arise, O Lord God, and go to your resting place, you and the ark of your might. Let your priests, O Lord God, be clothed with salvation, and let your saints **rejoice** in your goodness.

- 2 Chron 15:15 And all Judah **rejoiced** over the oath, for they had sworn with all their heart and had sought him with their whole desire, and he was found by them, and the Lord gave them rest all around.
- 2 Chron 20:27 Then they returned, every man of Judah and Jerusalem, and Jehoshaphat at their head, returning to Jerusalem with joy, for the Lord had made them **rejoice** over their enemies.
- 2 Chron 23:13 And when she looked, there was the king standing by his pillar at the entrance, and the captains and the trumpeters beside the king, and all the people of the land rejoicing and blowing trumpets, and the singers with their musical instruments leading in the celebration. And Athaliah tore her clothes and cried, "Treason! Treason!"
- 2 Chron 23:18 And Jehoiada posted watchmen for the house of the Lord under the direction of the Levitical priests and the Levites whom David had organized to be in charge of the house of the Lord, to offer burnt offerings to the Lord, as it is written in the Law of Moses, with rejoicing and with singing, according to the order of David.
- 2 Chron 23:21 So all the people of the land **rejoiced**, and the city was quiet after Athaliah had been put to death with the sword.
- 2 Chron 24:10 And all the princes and all the people **rejoiced** and brought their tax and dropped it into the chest until they had finished.
- 2 Chron 29:36 And Hezekiah and all the people **rejoiced** because God had prepared for the people, for the thing came about suddenly.

2:11 Serve the Lord with fear, and **rejoice** with trembling.

5:11 But let all who take refuge in you **rejoice**; let them ever sing for joy, and spread your protection over them, that those who love your name may exult in you.

9:14 that I may recount all your praises, that in the gates of the daughter of Zion I may **rejoice** in your salvation.

Pslm 32:11 Be glad in the Lord, and **rejoice**, O righteous, and shout for joy, all you upright in heart!

Pslm 35:9 Then my soul will **rejoice** in the Lord, exulting in his salvation.

Pslm 35:15 But at my stumbling they **rejoiced** and gathered; they gathered together against me; wretches whom I did not know tore at me without ceasing;

Pslm 35:19 Let not those **rejoice** over me who are wrongfully my foes, and let not those wink the eye who hate me without cause.

Pslm 35:24 Vindicate me, O Lord, my God, according to your righteousness, and let them not **rejoice** over me!

Pslm 35:26 Let them be put to shame and disappointed altogether who **rejoice** at my calamity! Let them be clothed with shame and dishonor who magnify themselves against me!

Pslm 38:16 For I said, "Only let them not **rejoice** over me, who boast against me when my foot slips!"

Pslm 40:16 But may all who seek you **rejoice** and be glad in you; may those who love your salvation say continually, "Great is the Lord!"

Pslm 48:11 Let Mount Zion be glad! Let the daughters of Judah **rejoice** because of your judgments!

Pslm 51:8 Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones that you have broken **rejoice**.

Pslm 53:6 Oh, that salvation for Israel would come out of Zion! When God restores the fortunes of his people, let Jacob **rejoice**, let Israel be glad.

Pslm 58:10 The righteous will **rejoice** when he sees the vengeance; he will bathe his feet in the blood of the wicked.

Pslm 63:11 But the king shall **rejoice** in God; all who swear by him shall exult, for the mouths of liars will be stopped.

Pslm 64:10 Let the righteous one **rejoice** in the Lord and take refuge in him! Let all the upright in heart exult!

Pslm 66:6 He turned the sea into dry land; they passed through the river on foot. There did we **rejoice** in him,

Pslm 70:4 May all who seek you **rejoice** and be glad in you! May those who love your salvation say evermore, "God is great!"

Pslm 85:6 Will you not revive us again, that your people may **rejoice** in you?

Pslm 89:42 You have exalted the right hand of his foes; you have made all his enemies **rejoice**.

Pslm 90:14 Satisfy us in the morning with your steadfast love, that we may **rejoice** and be glad all our days.

Pslm 96:11 Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth **rejoice**; let the sea roar, and all that fills it;

Pslm 97:1 The Lord reigns, let the earth **rejoice**; let the many coastlands be glad!

Pslm 97:8 Zion hears and is glad, and the daughters of Judah **rejoice**, because of your judgments, O Lord.

Pslm 97:12 **Rejoice** in the Lord, O you righteous, and give thanks to his holy name!

Pslm 104:31 May the glory of the Lord endure forever; may the Lord **rejoice** in his works,

Pslm 104:34 May my meditation be pleasing to him, for I **rejoice** in the Lord.

Pslm 105:3 Glory in his holy name; let the hearts of those who seek the Lord **rejoice**!

Pslm 106:5 that I may look upon the prosperity of your chosen ones, that I may **rejoice** in the gladness of your nation, that I may glory with your inheritance.

Pslm 118:24 This is the day that the Lord has made; let us **rejoice** and be glad in it.

Pslm 119:74 Those who fear you shall see me and **rejoice**, because I have hoped in your word.

Pslm 119:162 I **rejoice** at your word like one who finds great spoil.

Pslm 149:2 Let Israel be glad in his Maker; let the children of Zion **rejoice** in their King!

Prov 2:14 who **rejoice** in doing evil and delight in the perverseness of evil,

Prov 5:18 Let your fountain be blessed, and **rejoice** in the wife of your youth,

Prov 8:30 then I was beside him, like a master workman, and I was daily his delight, rejoicing before him always,

Prov 8:31 rejoicing in his inhabited world and delighting in the children of man.

Prov 11:10 When it goes well with the righteous, the city **rejoices**, and when the wicked perish there are shouts of gladness.

Prov 13:9 The light of the righteous **rejoices**, but the lamp of the wicked will be put out.

Prov 15:30 The light of the eyes **rejoices** the heart, and good news refreshes the bones.

Prov 23:24 The father of the righteous will greatly **rejoice**; he who fathers a wise son will be glad in him.

Prov 23:25 Let your father and mother be glad; let her who bore you **rejoice**.

Prov 24:17 Do not **rejoice** when your enemy falls, and let not your heart be glad when he stumbles,

Prov 29:2 When the righteous increase, the people **rejoice**, but when the wicked rule, the people groan.

Prov 29:6 An evil man is ensnared in his transgression, but a righteous man sings and **rejoices**.

Eccles 3:22 So I saw that there is nothing better than that a man should **rejoice** in his work, for that is his lot. Who can bring him to see what will be after him?

Eccles 4:16 There was no end of all the people, all of whom he led. Yet those who come later will not **rejoice** in him. Surely this also is vanity and a striving after wind.

- Eccles 5:19 Everyone also to whom God has given wealth and possessions and power to enjoy them, and to accept his lot and **rejoice** in his toil—this is the gift of God.
- Eccles 11:8 So if a person lives many years, let him **rejoice** in them all; but let him remember that the days of darkness will be many. All that comes is vanity.
- Eccles 11:9 **Rejoice**, O young man, in your youth, and let your heart cheer you in the days of your youth. Walk in the ways of your heart and the sight of your eyes. But know that for all these things God will bring you into judgment.
- Song 1:4 Draw me after you; let us run. The king has brought me into his chambers. We will exult and **rejoice** in you; we will extol your love more than wine; rightly do they love you.
- Isa 8:6 “Because this people has refused the waters of Shiloah that flow gently, and **rejoice** over Rezin and the son of Remaliah,
- Isa 9:3 You have multiplied the nation; you have increased its joy; they **rejoice** before you as with joy at the harvest, as they are glad when they divide the spoil.
- Isa 9:17 Therefore the Lord does not **rejoice** over their young men, and has no compassion on their fatherless and widows; for everyone is godless and an evildoer, and every mouth speaks folly. For all this his anger has not turned away, and his hand is stretched out still.
- Isa 14:8 The cypresses **rejoice** at you, the cedars of Lebanon, saying, ‘Since you were laid low, no woodcutter comes up against us.’
- Isa 14:29 **Rejoice** not, O Philistia, all of you, that the rod that struck you is broken, for from the serpent’s root will come forth an adder, and its fruit will be a flying fiery serpent.
- Isa 25:9 It will be said on that day, “Behold, this is our God; we have waited for him, that he might save us. This is the Lord; we have waited for him; let us be glad and **rejoice** in his salvation.”
- Isa 35:1 The wilderness and the dry land shall be glad; the desert shall **rejoice** and blossom like the crocus;
- Isa 35:2 it shall blossom abundantly and **rejoice** with joy and singing. The glory of Lebanon shall be given to it, the majesty of Carmel and Sharon. They shall see the glory of the Lord, the majesty of our God.

- Isa 41:16 you shall winnow them, and the wind shall carry them away, and the tempest shall scatter them. And you shall **rejoice** in the Lord; in the Holy One of Israel you shall glory.
- Isa 43:14 Thus says the Lord, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: "For your sake I send to Babylon and bring them all down as fugitives, even the Chaldeans, in the ships in which they **rejoice**.
- Isa 61:7 Instead of your shame there shall be a double portion; instead of dishonor they shall **rejoice** in their lot; therefore in their land they shall possess a double portion; they shall have everlasting joy.
- Isa 61:10 I will greatly **rejoice** in the Lord; my soul shall exult in my God, for he has clothed me with the garments of salvation; he has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself like a priest with a beautiful headdress, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.
- Isa 62:5 For as a young man marries a young woman, so shall your sons marry you, and as the bridegroom **rejoices** over the bride, so shall your God **rejoice** over you.
- Isa 65:13 Therefore thus says the Lord God: "Behold, my servants shall eat, but you shall be hungry; behold, my servants shall drink, but you shall be thirsty; behold, my servants shall **rejoice**, but you shall be put to shame;
- Isa 65:18 But be glad and **rejoice** forever in that which I create; for behold, I create Jerusalem to be a joy, and her people to be a gladness.
- Isa 65:19 I will **rejoice** in Jerusalem and be glad in my people; no more shall be heard in it the sound of weeping and the cry of distress.
- Isa 66:10 "**Rejoice** with Jerusalem, and be glad for her, all you who love her; **rejoice** with her in joy, all you who mourn over her;
- Isa 66:14 You shall see, and your heart shall **rejoice**; your bones shall flourish like the grass; and the hand of the Lord shall be known to his servants, and he shall show his indignation against his enemies.
- Jer 15:17 I did not sit in the company of revelers, nor did I **rejoice**; I sat alone, because your hand was upon me, for you had filled me with indignation.

- Jer 31:13 Then shall the young women **rejoice** in the dance, and the young men and the old shall be merry. I will turn their mourning into joy; I will comfort them, and give them gladness for sorrow.
- Jer 32:41 I will **rejoice** in doing them good, and I will plant them in this land in faithfulness, with all my heart and all my soul.
- Jer 41:13 And when all the people who were with Ishmael saw Johanan the son of Kareah and all the leaders of the forces with him, they **rejoiced**.
- Jer 50:11 “Though you **rejoice**, though you exult, O plunderers of my heritage, though you frolic like a heifer in the pasture, and neigh like stallions,
- Lam 2:17 The Lord has done what he purposed; he has carried out his word, which he commanded long ago; he has thrown down without pity; he has made the enemy **rejoice** over you and exalted the might of your foes.
- Lam 4:21 **Rejoice** and be glad, O daughter of Edom, you who dwell in the land of Uz; but to you also the cup shall pass; you shall become drunk and strip yourself bare.
- Ezek 7:12 The time has come; the day has arrived. Let not the buyer **rejoice**, nor the seller mourn, for wrath is upon all their multitude.
- Ezek 21:10 sharpened for slaughter, polished to flash like lightning! (Or shall we **rejoice**? You have despised the rod, my son, with everything of wood.)
- Ezek 25:6 For thus says the Lord God: Because you have clapped your hands and stamped your feet and **rejoiced** with all the malice within your soul against the land of Israel,
- Ezek 35:14 Thus says the Lord God: While the whole earth **rejoices**, I will make you desolate.
- Ezek 35:15 As you **rejoiced** over the inheritance of the house of Israel, because it was desolate, so I will deal with you; you shall be desolate, Mount Seir, and all Edom, all of it. Then they will know that I am the Lord.
- Hos 9:1 **Rejoice** not, O Israel! Exult not like the peoples; for you have played the whore, forsaking your God. You have loved a prostitute’s wages on all threshing floors.

- Hos 10:5 The inhabitants of Samaria tremble for the calf of Beth-aven. Its people mourn for it, and so do its idolatrous priests—those who **rejoiced** over it and over its glory— for it has departed from them.
- Joel 2:21 “Fear not, O land; be glad and **rejoice**, for the Lord has done great things!
- Joel 2:23 “Be glad, O children of Zion, and **rejoice** in the Lord your God, for he has given the early rain for your vindication; he has poured down for you abundant rain, the early and the latter rain, as before.
- Amos 6:13 you who **rejoice** in Lo-debar, who say, “Have we not by our own strength captured Karnaim for ourselves?”
- Obad 12 But do not gloat over the day of your brother in the day of his misfortune; do not **rejoice** over the people of Judah in the day of their ruin; do not boast in the day of distress.
- Micah 7:8 **Rejoice** not over me, O my enemy; when I fall, I shall rise; when I sit in darkness, the Lord will be a light to me.
- Hab 1:15 He brings all of them up with a hook; he drags them out with his net; he gathers them in his dragnet; so he **rejoices** and is glad.
- Hab 3:14 You pierced with his own arrows the heads of his warriors, who came like a whirlwind to scatter me, rejoicing as if to devour the poor in secret.
- Hab 3:18 yet I will **rejoice** in the Lord; I will take joy in the God of my salvation.
- Zeph 3:14 Sing aloud, O daughter of Zion; shout, O Israel! **Rejoice** and exult with all your heart, O daughter of Jerusalem!
- Zeph 3:17 The Lord your God is in your midst, a mighty one who will save; he will **rejoice** over you with gladness; he will quiet you by his love; he will exult over you with loud singing.
- Zech 2:10 Sing and **rejoice**, O daughter of Zion, for behold, I come and I will dwell in your midst, declares the Lord.
- Zech 4:10 For whoever has despised the day of small things shall **rejoice**, and shall see the plumb line in the hand of Zerubbabel. “These seven are the eyes of the Lord, which range through the whole earth.”

- Zech 9:9 **Rejoice** greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your king is coming to you; righteous and having salvation is he, humble and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.
- Zech 10:7 Then Ephraim shall become like a mighty warrior, and their hearts shall be glad as with wine. Their children shall see it and be glad; their hearts shall **rejoice** in the Lord.
- Matt 2:10 When they saw the star, they **rejoiced** exceedingly with great joy.
- Matt 5:12 **Rejoice** and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.
- Matt 18:13 And if he finds it, truly, I say to you, he **rejoices** over it more than over the ninety-nine that never went astray.
- Luk 1:14 And you will have joy and gladness, and many will **rejoice** at his birth,
- Luk 1:47 and my spirit **rejoices** in God my Savior,
- Luk 1:58 And her neighbors and relatives heard that the Lord had shown great mercy to her, and they **rejoiced** with her.
- Luk 6:23 **Rejoice** in that day, and leap for joy, for behold, your reward is great in heaven; for so their fathers did to the prophets.
- Luk 10:20 Nevertheless, do not **rejoice** in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but **rejoice** that your names are written in heaven.”
- Luk 10:21 In that same hour he **rejoiced** in the Holy Spirit and said, “I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that you have hidden these things from the wise and understanding and revealed them to little children; yes, Father, for such was your gracious will.
- Luk 13:17 As he said these things, all his adversaries were put to shame, and all the people **rejoiced** at all the glorious things that were done by him.
- Luk 15:5 And when he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing.
- Luk 15:6 And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and his neighbors, saying to them, ‘**Rejoice** with me, for I have found my sheep that was lost.’

- Luk 15:9 And when she has found it, she calls together her friends and neighbors, saying, ‘**Rejoice** with me, for I have found the coin that I had lost.’
- Luk 19:37 As he was drawing near—already on the way down the Mount of Olives—the whole multitude of his disciples began to **rejoice** and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen,
- John 3:29 The one who has the bride is the bridegroom. The friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, **rejoices** greatly at the bridegroom’s voice. Therefore this joy of mine is now complete.
- John 4:36 Already the one who reaps is receiving wages and gathering fruit for eternal life, so that sower and reaper may **rejoice** together.
- John 5:35 He was a burning and shining lamp, and you were willing to **rejoice** for a while in his light.
- John 8:56 Your father Abraham **rejoiced** that he would see my day. He saw it and was glad.”
- John 14:28 You heard me say to you, ‘I am going away, and I will come to you.’ If you loved me, you would have **rejoiced**, because I am going to the Father, for the Father is greater than I.
- John 16:20 Truly, truly, I say to you, you will weep and lament, but the world will **rejoice**. You will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will turn into joy.
- John 16:22 So also you have sorrow now, but I will see you again, and your hearts will **rejoice**, and no one will take your joy from you.
- Acts 2:26 therefore my heart was glad, and my tongue **rejoiced**; my flesh also will dwell in hope.
- Acts 5:41 Then they left the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer dishonor for the name.
- Acts 7:41 And they made a calf in those days, and offered a sacrifice to the idol and were rejoicing in the works of their hands.
- Acts 8:39 And when they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord carried Philip away, and the eunuch saw him no more, and went on his way rejoicing.

Acts 13:48 And when the Gentiles heard this, they began rejoicing and glorifying the word of the Lord, and as many as were appointed to eternal life believed.

Acts 15:31 And when they had read it, they **rejoiced** because of its encouragement.

Acts 16:34 Then he brought them up into his house and set food before them. And he **rejoiced** along with his entire household that he had believed in God.

Rom 5:2 Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we **rejoice** in hope of the glory of God.

Rom 5:3 More than that, we **rejoice** in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance,

Rom 5:11 More than that, we also **rejoice** in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation.

Rom 12:12 **Rejoice** in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer.

Rom 12:15 **Rejoice** with those who **rejoice**, weep with those who weep.

Rom 15:10 And again it is said, "**Rejoice**, O Gentiles, with his people."

Rom 16:19 For your obedience is known to all, so that I **rejoice** over you, but I want you to be wise as to what is good and innocent as to what is evil.

1 Cor 7:30 and those who mourn as though they were not mourning, and those who **rejoice** as though they were not rejoicing, and those who buy as though they had no goods,

1 Cor 12:26 If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all **rejoice** together.

1 Cor 13:6 it does not **rejoice** at wrongdoing, but **rejoices** with the truth.

1 Cor 16:17 I **rejoice** at the coming of Stephanas and Fortunatus and Achaicus, because they have made up for your absence,

2 Cor 2:3 And I wrote as I did, so that when I came I might not suffer pain from those who should have made me **rejoice**, for I felt sure of all of you, that my joy would be the joy of you all.

- 2 Cor 6:10 as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, yet possessing everything.
- 2 Cor 7:7 and not only by his coming but also by the comfort with which he was comforted by you, as he told us of your longing, your mourning, your zeal for me, so that I **rejoiced** still more.
- 2 Cor 7:9 As it is, I **rejoice**, not because you were grieved, but because you were grieved into repenting. For you felt a godly grief, so that you suffered no loss through us.
- 2 Cor 7:13 Therefore we are comforted. And besides our own comfort, we **rejoiced** still more at the joy of Titus, because his spirit has been refreshed by you all.
- 2 Cor 7:16 I **rejoice**, because I have perfect confidence in you.
- 2 Cor 13:11 Finally, brothers, **rejoice**. Aim for restoration, comfort one another, agree with one another, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you.
- Gal 4:27 For it is written, “**Rejoice**, O barren one who does not bear; break forth and cry aloud, you who are not in labor! For the children of the desolate one will be more than those of the one who has a husband.”
- Phil 1:18 What then? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is proclaimed, and in that I **rejoice**. Yes, and I will **rejoice**,
- Phil 2:17 Even if I am to be poured out as a drink offering upon the sacrificial offering of your faith, I am glad and **rejoice** with you all.
- Phil 2:18 Likewise you also should be glad and **rejoice** with me.
- Phil 2:28 I am the more eager to send him, therefore, that you may **rejoice** at seeing him again, and that I may be less anxious.
- Phil 3:1 Finally, my brothers, **rejoice** in the Lord. To write the same things to you is no trouble to me and is safe for you.
- Phil 4:4 **Rejoice** in the Lord always; again I will say, **Rejoice**.
- Phil 4:10 I **rejoiced** in the Lord greatly that now at length you have revived your concern for me. You were indeed concerned for me, but you had no opportunity.

- Col 1:24 Now I **rejoice** in my sufferings for your sake, and in my flesh I am filling up what is lacking in Christ's afflictions for the sake of his body, that is, the church,
- Col 2:5 For though I am absent in body, yet I am with you in spirit, rejoicing to see your good order and the firmness of your faith in Christ.
- 1 Thess 5:16 **Rejoice** always,
- 1 Pet 1:6 In this you **rejoice**, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials,
- 1 Pet 1:8 Though you have not seen him, you love him. Though you do not now see him, you believe in him and **rejoice** with joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory,
- 1 Pet 4:13 But **rejoice** insofar as you share Christ's sufferings, that you may also **rejoice** and be glad when his glory is revealed.
- 2 John 4 I **rejoiced** greatly to find some of your children walking in the truth, just as we were commanded by the Father.
- 3 John 3 For I **rejoiced** greatly when the brothers came and testified to your truth, as indeed you are walking in the truth.
- Rev 11:10 and those who dwell on the earth will **rejoice** over them and make merry and exchange presents, because these two prophets had been a torment to those who dwell on the earth.
- Rev 12:12 Therefore, **rejoice**, O heavens and you who dwell in them! But woe to you, O earth and sea, for the devil has come down to you in great wrath, because he knows that his time is short!"
- Rev 18:20 **Rejoice** over her, O heaven, and you saints and apostles and prophets, for God has given judgment for you against her!"
- Rev 19:7 Let us **rejoice** and exult and give him the glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and his Bride has made herself ready;
